

AREAS OF INTERVENTION


The scope of our work is focused in 28 provinces distributed across 7 regions of Peru.

+ 10 475 people (4151 women and 6324 men).



+ 500 organizaciones beneficiarias





CITIZEN INVOLVEMENT AND DEMOCRACY



20 citizenship rights workshops, with more than 1,500 people, where representatives of organizations developed initiatives with their bases and got involved in community forums.





2816 women and 3634 men, of whom 2058 are young people, had been trained in conceptualization, planning and citizen monitoring; that is, in the use of transparency portals, report elaboration; this training also included local development, communal leadership, and conflict resolution, among other skills.





205 women and 127 men carry out advocacy actions for the approval of proposals that contribute to the reduction of socioeconomic gaps.



MITIGATION AND ADAPTATION TO THE EFFECTS OF CLIMATE CHANGE



521 women and **1,800** men producers have implemented mechanisms for adaptation and risk management for climate change.





17 associations of small producers have incorporated circular economy mechanisms into their production processes.





More than 400 hectares of cultivated forests and agroforestry systems.



SUSTAINABLE RURAL DEVELOPMENT



4460 (1674 women and 2886 men) trained have upgraded their various value chains and increased their incomes.





679 production units have received technical advice and support from CEDEPAS Norte.





We have assisted more than 30 organizations in obtaining quality certification for more than 100 products in various value chains, enabling them to access more advantageous markets.

WORKING FOR RURAL WOMEN



1674 women trained to improve productive conditions and increase their income.



27 community help centers established for the prevention of gender-based violence.



438 women trained to play a role as community advocates.



4 women's associations have capitalized more than S/400,000, through financing from national funds such as Agroideas.



16 local and regional coordination bodies have instruments to promote joint actions for the prevention of gender-based violence.



3 local governments allocate a budget for violence prevention actions through the opening of the 1002 budget program.
